

Best Practice - I

Title- Financial Assistance to the Economically disadvantaged students by the College

Goal- The aim of this practice is to provide financial support to the economically disadvantaged students in order to fulfil some of their educational needs.

The context- A large number of students of the College come from rural areas and it is observed that the economic status of such students is generally not good. Many students come from BPL families and such students regularly face financial problems. Keeping in mind the economic backwardness of such students, the College decided to provide financial help to them.

The Practice- This practice was first conceived at a meeting in a Teachers' Unit meeting. Accordingly a fund Students' Aid Fund was created with the contribution from teachers, employees and students. During the session, financially weak and needy students were identified and assistance was given.

Evidence of success- The practice was found beneficial for poor students as the recipients have continued their studies which would not have been possible for them otherwise.

Problem encountered- As the number of needy students is high, it is difficult to pick out the short listed students.

Best Practice - II

Title- College campus as 'Horn Free Zone'

Goal- To make the campus free from noise pollution as an effort to ensure clean and green environment

The Context- It is a norm that all educational institutions and hospitals should be free from noise pollution. It has been observed that various type of vehicles blow horn frequently in the campus and classes are disturbed. Since ours is an educational institution, the college took upon itself to make it a horn free one.

The Practice- The college campus has been made a 'Horn Free Zone' and initiative has been taken to put up sign boards to indicate that at different locations including both ends of the road that runs through the campus. Teachers, non-teaching staff and students are encouraged not to blow horn of their vehicles in the campus.

Evidence of success- This practice was great impact as most of the vehicles made it a habit not to blow horns near the campus.

Problem encountered- It is quite difficult to convert the area as complete horn free as some of the bikers do not heed the sign and tend to blow their horns to impress the girl students.
