Activity Title	Flood Relief at Kaliabor, Nagaon
Date	August 15, 2017
Organised by	Extension and Outreach Activity Cell, IQAC & NGCSU
Collaboration with	
Note	Every year during summer season, flood creates havoc in different parts of Assam. In August, 2017 the embankment of river Brahmaputra was breached and many areas of Nagaon and Kaliabor sub-division in Nagaon District were submerged. Thousands of people became homeless and they have to take shelter in National highways and other highlands. Realizing themisery of the people, the NGCSU decided to donate the entire amount meant for Freshers' Social scheduled to be held on 17th August, 2017 to the flood victims. On the initiative of the NGCSU and IQAC, relief materials such as essential food items, medicines, baby food, sanitary napkins etc. were distributed. Items worth around 1.5 lakh rupees were distributed among the affected people with the assistance of civil administration.
