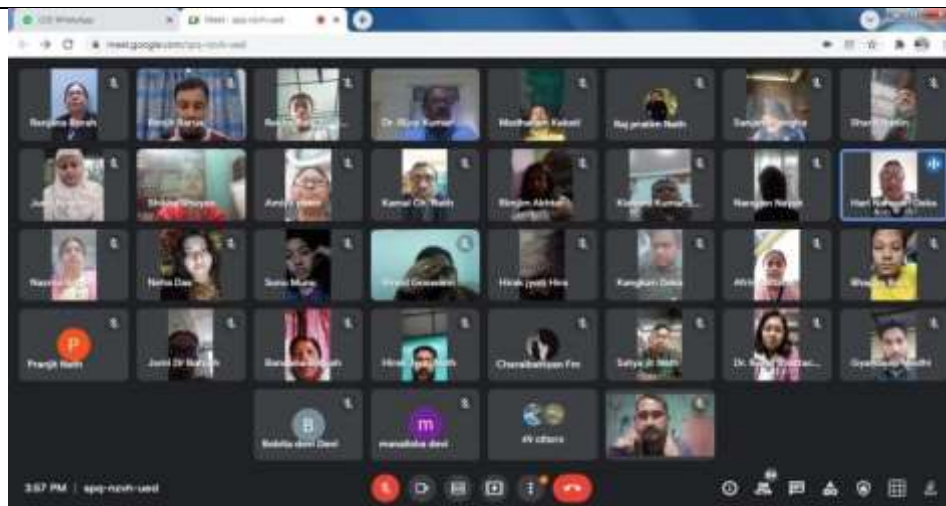

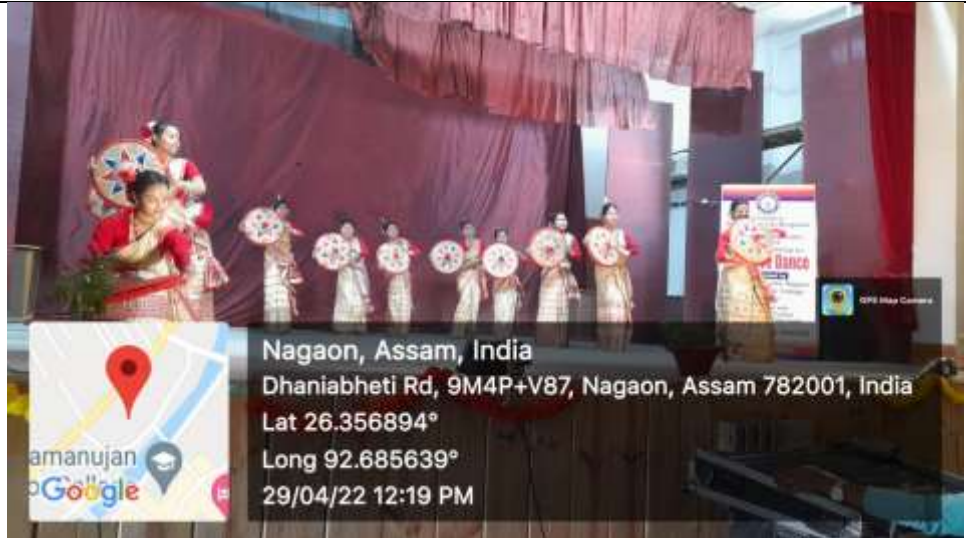
Activity Title	One-week workshop on creative dance


