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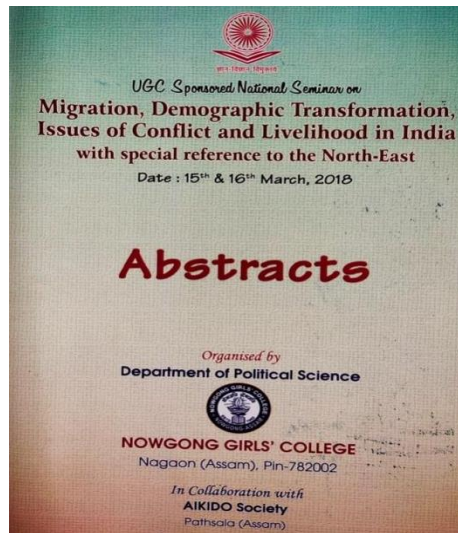

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Activity Title	Workshop on Research Methodology

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




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Activity Title	One Day e-Workshop on 'Basics of Geoinformatics'

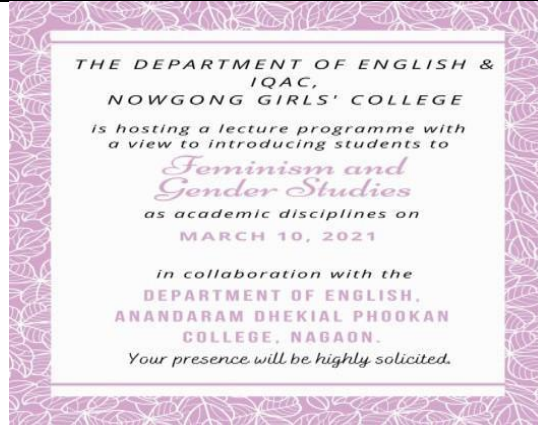

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




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Activity Title	Popular Talk “Classical Physics and its Limitations”

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



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Activity Title	Workshop and induction program on basic laboratory instruments in physics

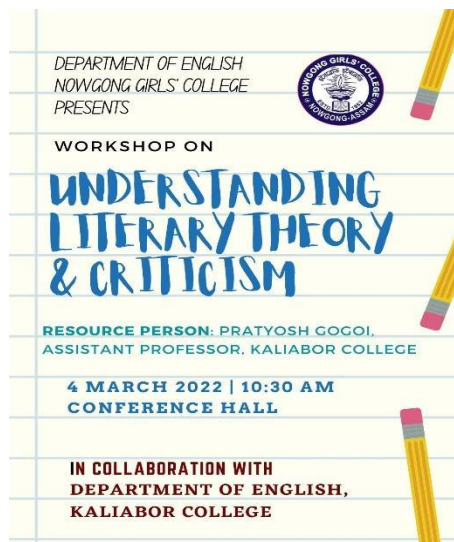
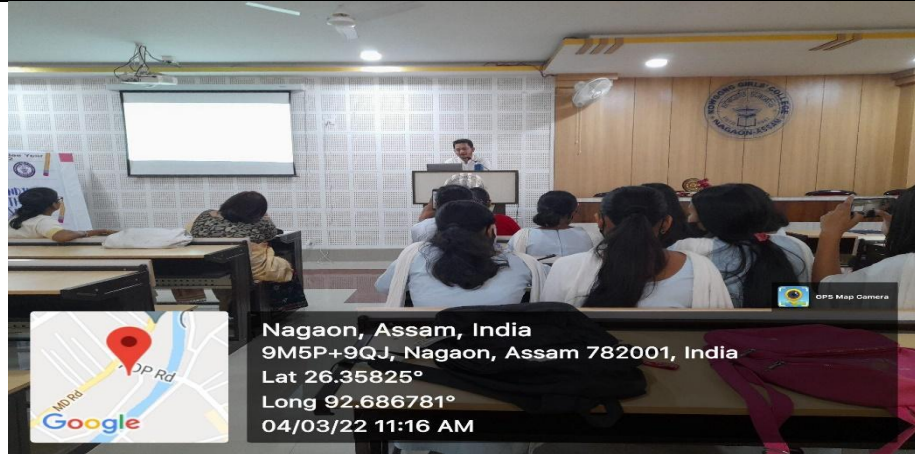

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Activity Title	Workshop on Methods and Techniques in Social Geography
